Clara Barton. Born December 25, 1821. Birthplace North Oxford, MA. Died April 12, 1912. Grave Site North Oxford, MA. Contribution Known as the “ Angel of the Battlefield ” for her work in administering to the needs of wounded soldiers during the Civil War. She was the founder of the American Red Cross. Clarissa “ Clara ” Harlow Barton was born on December 25, 1821 in North Oxford, Massachusetts.

Clara Barton began her Civil War service by responding to this situation: she decided to work to provide supplies for the troops, advertising widely and successfully after the battle at Bull Run. She talked the Surgeon-General into letting her personally distribute supplies to wounded and sick soldiers, and she personally cared for some who needed nursing services.

Clara Barton: Civil War Nurse, Red Cross Founder

Clara Barton (1821 – 1912) Clara Barton began her life of service at age 11 when, for two years, she cared for her brother, who suffered serious injury in a fall from a barn. She became a teacher and later worked at the U.S. Patent Office in Washington, D.C., but when the Civil War broke out, Barton found her true calling.

This organization, founded in 1864, was dedicated to providing medical aid and other assistance to people wounded in wartime. In 1870 a war broke out between Germany and France. This war, known as the Franco-Prussian War (1870 – 71), gave Barton an opportunity to see how the International Red Cross operated.
