A regular paperback book can be any size that you want it. Most book printers will be able to accommodate sizes ranging from small A6 (105x74mm / 4.13x2.91 inches) pocketbooks to larger A4 landscape (297x210mm / 11.69x8.26 inches) books.

The standard size for a mass market paperback is around 4.25" by 6.87". Books at this size usually come with a tiny typeface and spine flexibility ranging from minimal to moderate. KDP standard book sizes include most standard book dimensions, but they exclude the mass market paperback size.

Standard Book Sizes, Dimension, and Specifications - Chart ...

The size and proportions of a book will thus depend on the size of the original sheet of paper used in producing the book. For example, if a sheet 19 inches (480 mm) by 25 inches (640 mm) is used to print a quarto, the resulting book will be approximately 12 1 ? 2 inches (320 mm) tall and 9 1 ? 2 inches (240 mm) wide, before trimming. Because the size of paper used has differed over the years and localities, the sizes of books of the same format will also differ.

You'll notice the table above lists two or three trim sizes for each book type. And that's just a general idea of the range that is most common. For example, most fiction lands in the area of 6 x 9, but trade paperbacks tend to be on the smaller side, more like 5.5 x 8.5 or even smaller.

A mass-market paperback is a small, usually non-illustrated, inexpensive bookbinding format. This includes the U.K. A-format books of 110 mm x 178 mm (4 3⁄8 in x 7 in) and the U.S. "pocketbook" format books of a similar size. They have been historically printed on relatively low-quality paper.
