In one passage from her posthumously published autobiography *The Living of Charlotte Perkins Gilman* (1935), she remarks after visiting her ill father in a sanitarium that a future civilized society would not "maintain such a horror." In 1935, after living three years with a cancer she had been told would kill her within a year and a half, Gilman ended her life by inhaling chloroform.~~

~~Gilman died on August 17, 1935, in Pasadena, California - she ended her own life by taking an overdose of chloroform.
